1. Read moderately complex work orders, follow moderately complex production drawings and sample assemblies, or receive verbal instructions regarding duties to be performed.
2. Position and align parts in specified relationship to each other in fixture, or other holding device.
3. Crimp, stake, screw, bolt, rivet, or perform similar operations to join or secure parts in place.
4. Mount components, such as transformers, passives, integrated circuits, and sockets, on printed circuit boards.
5. Mount assembled components on upper level assemblies.
6. Perform basic soldering as it applies to Mechanical Assembly.
7. Install finished assemblies or subassemblies.
8. Maintain department specific records.
9. Work with minimal supervision from the Production Department Supervisor.
10. Other duties as assigned.

Requirements:

1. Familiar with electronics components: resistors, capacitors, diodes, inductors, transistors, ICs, etc..
2. Minimum of 4+ years' experience in a manufacturing/assembly line
3. Expected to read and comprehend process documentation including Bills of Materials and Assembly drawings.
4. Expected to communicate well in English both verbally and in written format.
5. Candidates should be very organized with the ability to keep count of parts.
6. Candidates should have the ability to carry out detailed written or oral instructions.
